2. Update on status of bike plan

3. Discussion of parking study relevance to bicycling – summarized volatile council meeting re: reconciliation of parking permit regulations in Jackson-Witherspoon neighborhood. All should take survey – encourage recommendation for bike parking downtown, encourage elimination of on-street parking on Wiggins/Hamilton, and Witherspoon for bike lanes. Tineke did research on how other communities resolve parking vs bike facility trade-offs. Recommendations for bike parking locations: west side of Witherspoon, walkway next to Hinksons, new construction near post office, convert parking meters to kiosk style & make obsolete meters into bike racks. Out of center parking garages or lots with bike share and frequent shuttles would provide alternate spaces and allow elimination of spaces which conflict with bike lanes (especially easy for employee parking). Look at pedestrian-only areas. Consider making on-street parking more expensive than garage parking. Public and private garages should be same price. Perimeter garages should have less expensive rates. Higher rates for events. Discounts for mobility impaired. Currently 90 free permits for seniors awarded by lottery. Possibly reserve shoulders for bike lanes during rush hours, parking at night. Also possibly special event permits to occupy bike lane.
