AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING LOW SPEED VEHICLES OPERATING ON ROADWAYS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON AND AMENDING THE "CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY, 1968".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Princeton as follows:

- Section 11-30 of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968" that sets forth words and phrases and their meanings as to motor driven vehicles is amended by adding thereto in alphabetical order the following new phrase and meaning:
 - Low Speed Vehicle. A four-wheeled vehicle with an attainable speed or more than twenty (20) miles per hour but no more than twenty-five (25) miles per hour on a paved surface. It cannot be powered by gas or diesel fuel and must comply with federal safety standards as noted in CFRS. 517.500 and the requirements of *N.J.S.A.* 39:4-31.2(b) requiring the display on the vehicle of a safety decal as provided by the manufacturer affixed in a conspicuous place on the rear of the vehicle and state in prominent lettering "25 MPH Vehicle". It must be titled, registered and insured in the State of New Jersey.
- Article IV of Chapter 11 of said Code is amended by including therein a NEW Section 11-31.5.1 which shall read as follows:

Section 11-31.5.1. Operating of Low Speed Vehicle.

A Low Speed Vehicle as that term is defined in Section 11-30 hereinabove may operate on Faculty Road and on the entire length of any Township roadway for which the established speed limit is thirty-five (35) miles per hour our less.

3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided for by law.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Princeton Township Committee held on February 23, 2009 and will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing thereon at a meeting of said Township Committee to be held at the Princeton Township Municipal Complex, 400 Witherspoon Street, on March 9, 2009 which begins at 7:00 p.m.
