

**AN ORDINANCE BY THE
TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON
CONCERNING THE SPEED LIMIT
ON SYCAMORE ROAD, AMENDING
THE "CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY, 1968",
AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO.
2009-6.**

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2009-6, adopted by the Princeton Township Committee on March 9, 2009, confirmed a thirty (30) miles per hour speed limit on Sycamore Road between Harrison Street and Riverside Drive West; and

WHEREAS, the Princeton Township Police Department Traffic Safety Bureau has subsequently conducted a new speed survey and recommended that the appropriate speed limit for said road is twenty-five (25) miles per hour; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee wishes, therefore, to reduce the speed limit of Sycamore Road between Harrison Street and Riverside Drive West to twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of the Princeton as follows:

1. Ordinance No. 2009-6, as adopted on March 9, 2009, be and hereby is repealed and is of no further effect.
2. Sec. 11.2(f) of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968", which establishes a thirty (30) mile per hour speed limit for various streets or parts of streets within the Township of Princeton, is amended by deleting therefrom the following designated Road:

SYCAMORE ROAD, both directions, between Harrison Street and Riverside Drive West.

3. Section 11.2(e) of said Code, which establishes a twenty-five (25) mile per hour speed limit for various streets or parts of streets in the Township, is amended by adding thereto the following designated Road:

SYCAMORE ROAD, both directions, between Harrison Street and Riverside Drive West.
4. Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above-referenced twenty-five (25) mile per hour speed limit as authorized by the New Jersey Department of Transportation.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided for by law.
