IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING CHERRY VALLEY ROAD TREE REMOVAL PROJECT

On Monday March 13th through Friday March 17th, weather permitting, Stonaker Tree Service, a subcontractor to Mazza Mulch, will continue removing trees along Cherry Valley Road for the road widening project scheduled for later this year. Tree removal will be focused east of the Cherry Hill Road intersection. When that section is complete, on or about Thursday, March 16th, the contractor will begin removing trees west of the Cherry Hill Road intersection. Should inclement weather occur, the work will be rescheduled to the next business day.

Cherry Valley Road will be closed to through traffic between the intersection with Cherry Hill Road (Princeton side) and the intersection with George Drive (Princeton side) between the hours of 9:30 AM and 2:30 PM. The contractor will endeavor to keep Cherry Hill Road open during work hours, in both directions and in both municipalities. Detour signage will be posted to direct traffic around the work area.

Residents can access their homes during work hours, but are advised to use caution and allow for additional travel time. Please be advised that vehicular access to your homes may not be consistently accommodated during work hours. For the safety of all involved, residents are asked to schedule residential service calls outside the working hours of 9:30 AM and 2:30 PM. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and mail delivery.

Residents are advised to have their garbage and recycling ready the night before the pick-up day as the hauler has been requested to do a pick-up prior to work beginning work at 9:30 AM.
