## Princeton Sidewalk Repair Project Update – October 2, 2017

Please be advised that the 2017 Sidewalk Repair Project is continuing on Franklin Avenue for the week of October 2. The contractor has completed new sidewalks and driveway aprons between Harrison Street North and Tee-Ar Place. Work continues on sidewalks and driveway aprons on the south side of Franklin Avenue between Tee-Ar Place and Snowden Lane. Upon the completion of the south side, the contractor will switch to the north side beginning at Tee-Ar Place.

As a reminder, if you receive a letter from the Contractor about upcoming work adjacent to your property please aide in the construction by parking your vehicle(s) on the street, away from the work area. Overnight street parking is acceptable throughout construction. Newly poured concrete driveway aprons should not be driven on for three consecutive days. Your assistance in tolerating the temporary inconvenience associated with this work, which will lead to a permanent improvement of your neighborhood, is greatly appreciated.

Grass seed and topsoil has been installed in grassy areas affected by construction. Please help us aid the growth of the grass by watering these areas at least once per day until the grass reaches approximately 3". It is important to keep the topsoil moist so the seed does not dry out.
