- 3. THE PLAN SUBMITTED BY THE APPLICANT MUST INCLUDE THE EXACT LOCATION (NEAREST STREET ADDRESS OR INTERSECTION) AND DIMENSIONS OF ALL OPENINGS PROPOSED.
- 4. AS A CONDITION TO THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT, THE PERMITTEE AGREES TO REPLACE AT ITS OWN COST AND EXPENSE, THE PORTION OF THE STREET, CURB, GUTTER, AND/OR SIDEWALK DISTURBED, TO THE SAME OR BETTER CONDITION AS IT WAS PRIOR THE TIME OF THE START OF THE WORK.
