## **Ordinance #2017-3**

AN **ORDINANCE**  $\mathbf{BY}$ THE MUNICIPALITY **OF PRINCETON** REGULATING NO PARKING AND TWO HOUR PARKING ON THE EAST SIDE **STREET** OF PINE AMENDING THE "CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF PRINCETON, NEW **JERSEY, 1974**"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Section 19-22(a)(1) of the Code is hereby further amended as follows:

Sec. 19-22. No parking zones.

- (a) No parking at any time.
- (1) Designated. No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the following streets or parts thereof:

Pine Street, east side, from Route NJ 27 (Nassau Street) to a point thirty-five feet northerly.

Section 2. Section 19-23(d)(1) of the Code is hereby further amended as follows:

Sec. 19-23. Nonmetered on-street parking zones.

- (d) Parking time limited to two hours.
- (1) No person shall park a vehicle for longer than two hours at any time between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M., Monday through Saturday, upon any of the following streets or parts of streets:

Pine Street, east side, from a point thirty-five feet north of Route NJ 27 (Nassau Street) to a point seven hundred eighty feet northerly.

<u>Section 3.</u> The appropriate No Parking signs shall be posted to implement the requirements of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and shall become part of the new Princeton Code once completed and adopted.

The purpose of the ordinance is to amend the no parking zone and nonmetered on-street parking zone on the east side of Pine Street in order to correlate with existing signage and striping in accordance with endorsements from the Princeton Police Department and the Traffic Safety Committee.
