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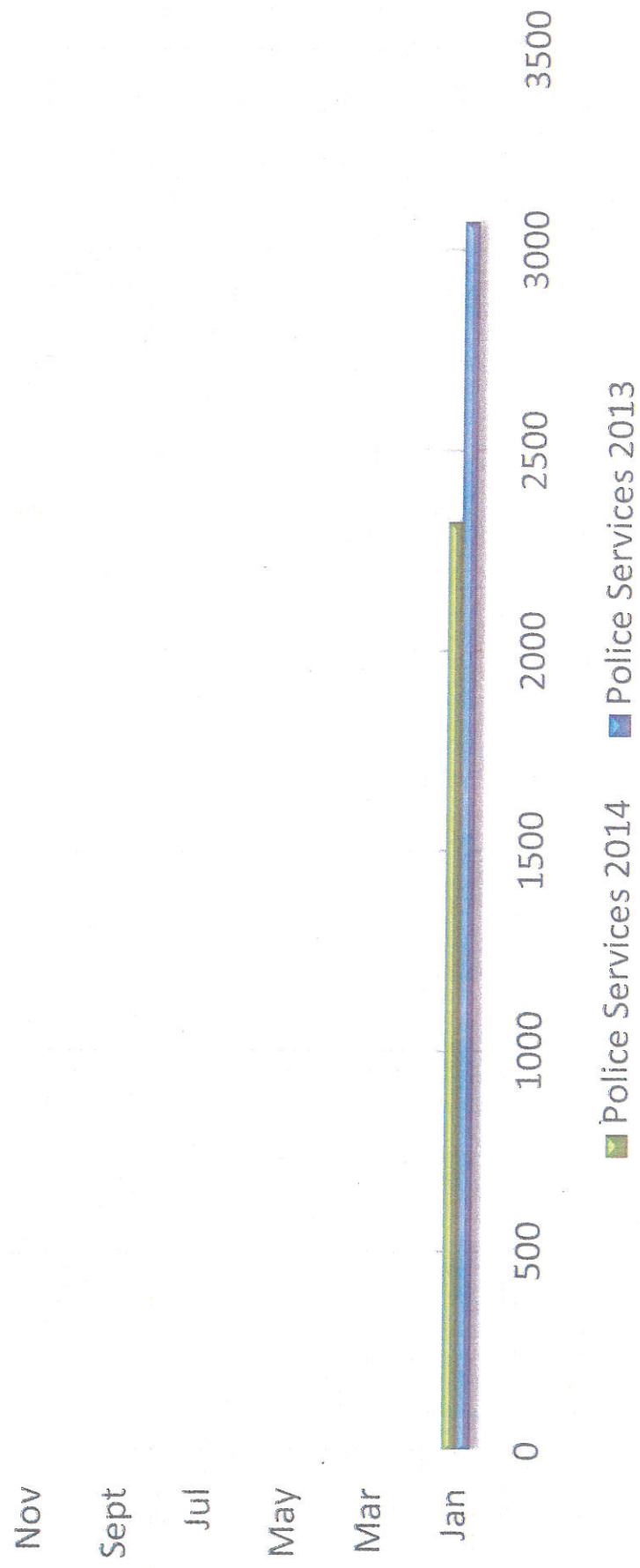
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# **CRIME SUMMARY**

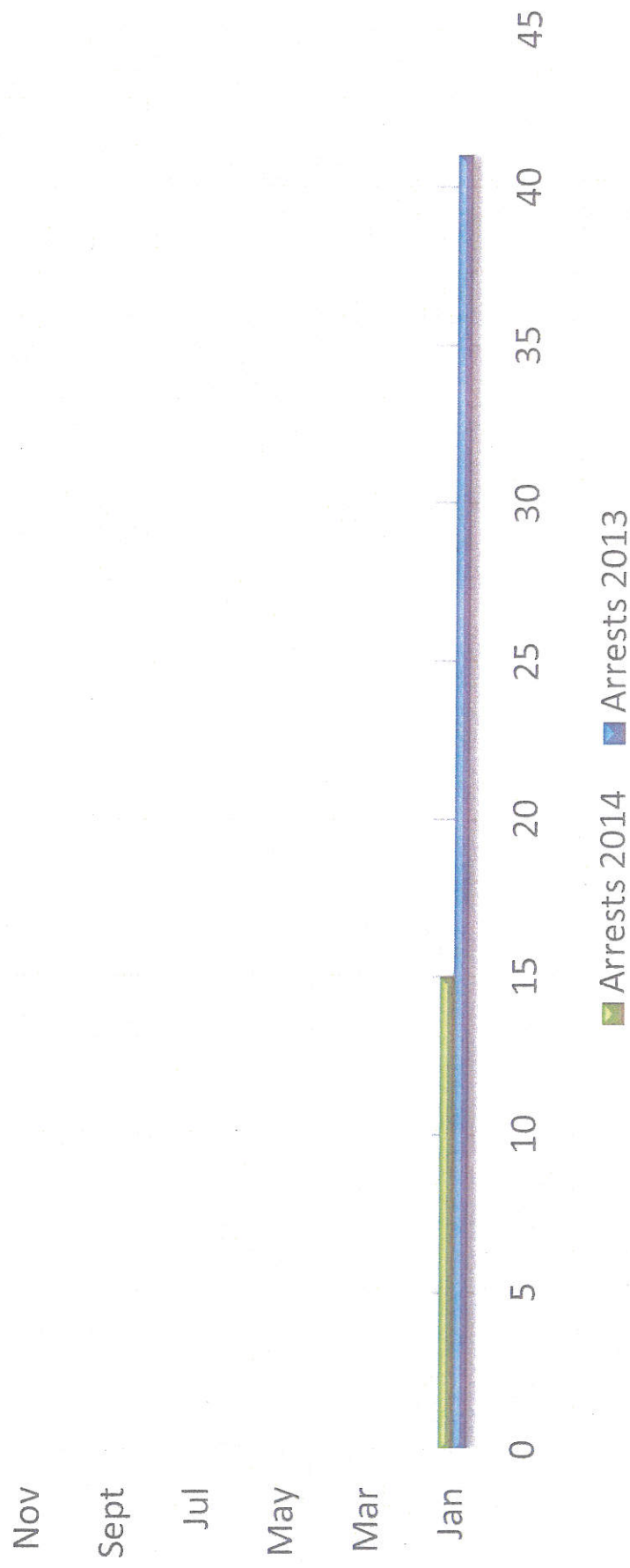
The Princeton Police Department responded to two thousand, three hundred and twenty (2,320) police services activities during the month of January 2014.

#### **Family Crisis or Mental Health Incidents**

A 16 year old female with bi-polar disorder and depression attempted to strike her mother in the face during a therapy session. There were no injuries and the child was brought for a mental health evaluation in order to admit her into an inpatient program.

During an outpatient program for mental health issues two female patients, one 13 years old and one 16 years old, entered into a physical fight upon mutual consent. During the altercation a nurse intervened and was struck in the forehead by the 16 year old female. Due to the circumstances the victim did not wish to pursue charges and the juvenile was expelled from the program.

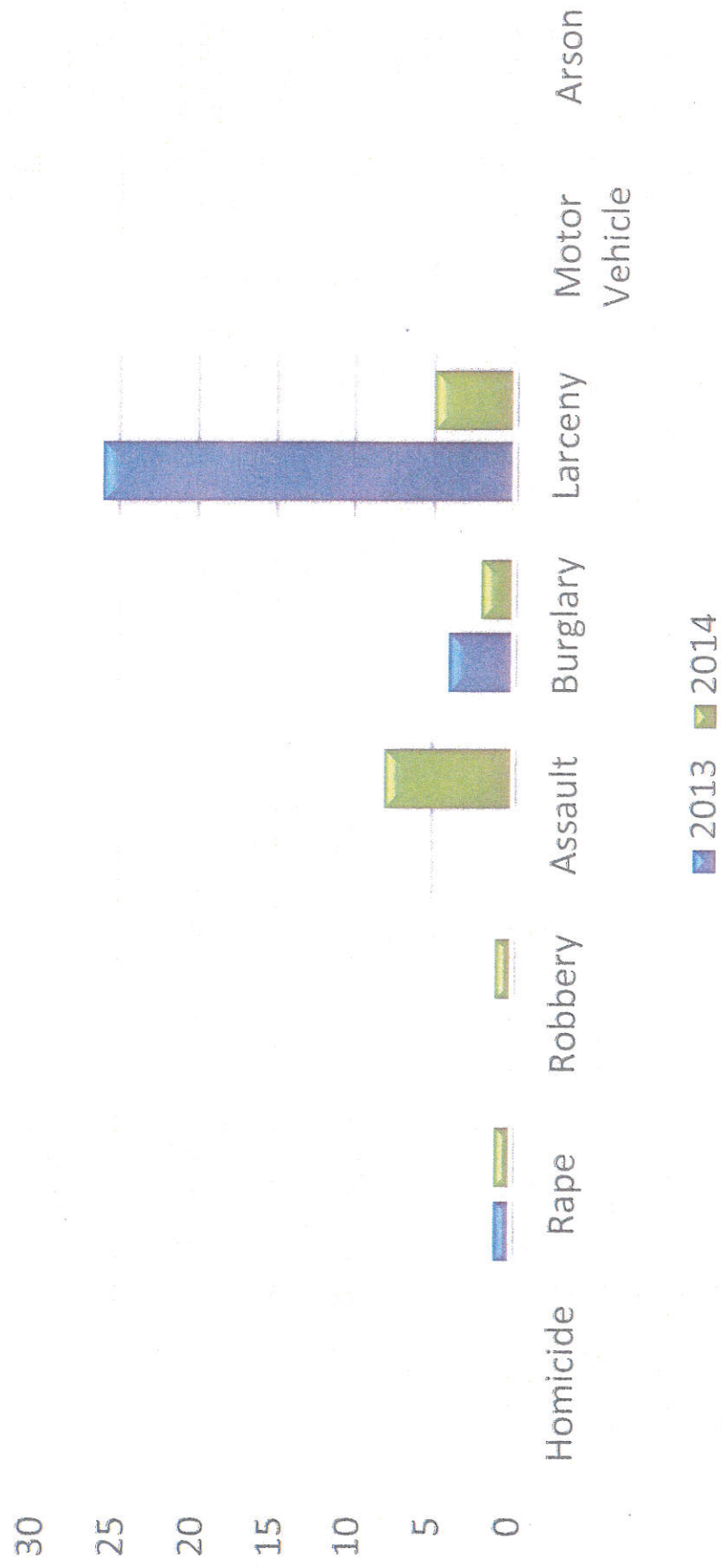
#### **Division of Child Protection and Permanency Referrals (formerly DYFS)**

An 11<sup>th</sup> grade Princeton High School student reported to staff that her parents occasionally hit her when she does not do well in school. No visible injuries were present and notification was made to DCP&P.

#### **Community Programs and Meetings**

We brought the "Enough Abuse" National Campaign for the Prevention of Sexual Child Abuse to present to the Latinos en Progreso group made up of parents and family members of John Witherspoon Middle School students. In addition, I presented to the teenage children of the Latinos en Progreso group along with a Child Abuse Prevention (CAP) presenter and another CAP presenter educated the grammar school age children on personal safety and child abuse issues.
