#### Juvenile Report-April 2014

#### **Juveniles Petitioned In Family Court**

A seventeen year old female paid an adult male to purchase alcohol from a liquor store and subsequently took possession of it. She had a previous history of juvenile delinquency and was charged with Under Age Possession of Alcohol. The adult was charged with providing alcohol to a minor.

A fifteen year old male disclosed to his Princeton High School Peer Group that he felt bullied by another student and revealed that he had a knife in his backpack. He then made multiple statements threatening the life of the student and left the room. The Peer Group Leaders followed the boy, engaged him in conversation to diffuse the situation and brought him to the Princeton High School staff. He was subsequently charged with Possession of a Weapon in an Educational Institution and Terroristic Threats.

#### Juveniles Afforded a Station House Adjustment

Two thirteen year old boys stole an unsecured bicycle valued at \$350.00 from the bike rack at the Princeton Public Library. They were ordered to pay restitution and write a letter of apology to the victim.

#### **Curbside Warning**

The lost wallet of a 17 year old female was found containing a fictitious identification identifying her as 21 years old. The juvenile was given a warning and the identification was retained for destruction.

A ten year old boy shoplifted a toy while in Jazaam's toy store. Upon patrol's arrival he was released to his parent with a curbside warning.

A 10 year old juvenile reported being bullied at school by another 10 year old student when he excluded him, called him names and had physical contact with him. Both juveniles and their guardians met with Detective Henderson and the matter was resolved without the need of formal charges.

#### **DCP&P Referrals (formerly DYFS)**

A referral was made to the Department of Child Protection after a mother evicted her fourteen year old daughter from her home without appropriate arrangements or supervision.

#### **Family Crisis or Mental Health Incidents**

A seventeen year old male with a history of mental illness engaged in a heated verbal altercation and cursed at his mother. The situation was diffused upon police arrival.

A seventeen year old male cursed at his mother and called her names after she took the keys to the BMW she allows him to drive because he refused to take care of college application paperwork. Upon the arrival of the police the situation was diffused.



Total Arrests 2014









Total - Offenses 2014






