### **Juvenile Report –December 2014**

#### **Curbside Warning**

A fourteen year old boy found an iPhone that was misplaced in the boy's bathroom at the Princeton High School and took it home. The telephone was immediately turned over to police after it was tracked to his address.

#### **Juvenile Family Crisis/Mental Health Incidents**

After being suspended, a 16 year old male student of The Hun School of Princeton advised the staff that his family was going to pick him up from campus. Staff learned the next day that the family had not picked him up and he was reported missing to the police. Investigation revealed the boy had called a car service to retrieve him the previous day, he was staying at a hotel in West Windsor and he was subsequently reunited with his family.

A sixteen year old female reported she was in fear of her family and exhibited concerning behaviors. The Division of Child Protection and Permanency was notified and arrangements were made for further mental health services to be provided.

A seventeen year old female was reported missing by the Princeton High School after her mother advised school officials she had not seen her in three days. The mother reported she believed she was staying with her boyfriend in Newark, however neither she or her husband knew who he was. Her mother subsequently advised police she was giving her daughter permission to stay where she was and after bringing her daughter to the police station to verify she was fine, the investigation was closed.

#### **Investigations**

Johnson Park Elementary School reported an 8 year old female with Autism told her mother a 7 year old boy at school touched her inappropriately. A forensic interview was conducted with the female child which failed to disclose any inappropriate behavior. The male child was interviewed and denied touching her in an inappropriate area of her body. DCP&P was notified for follow up services.

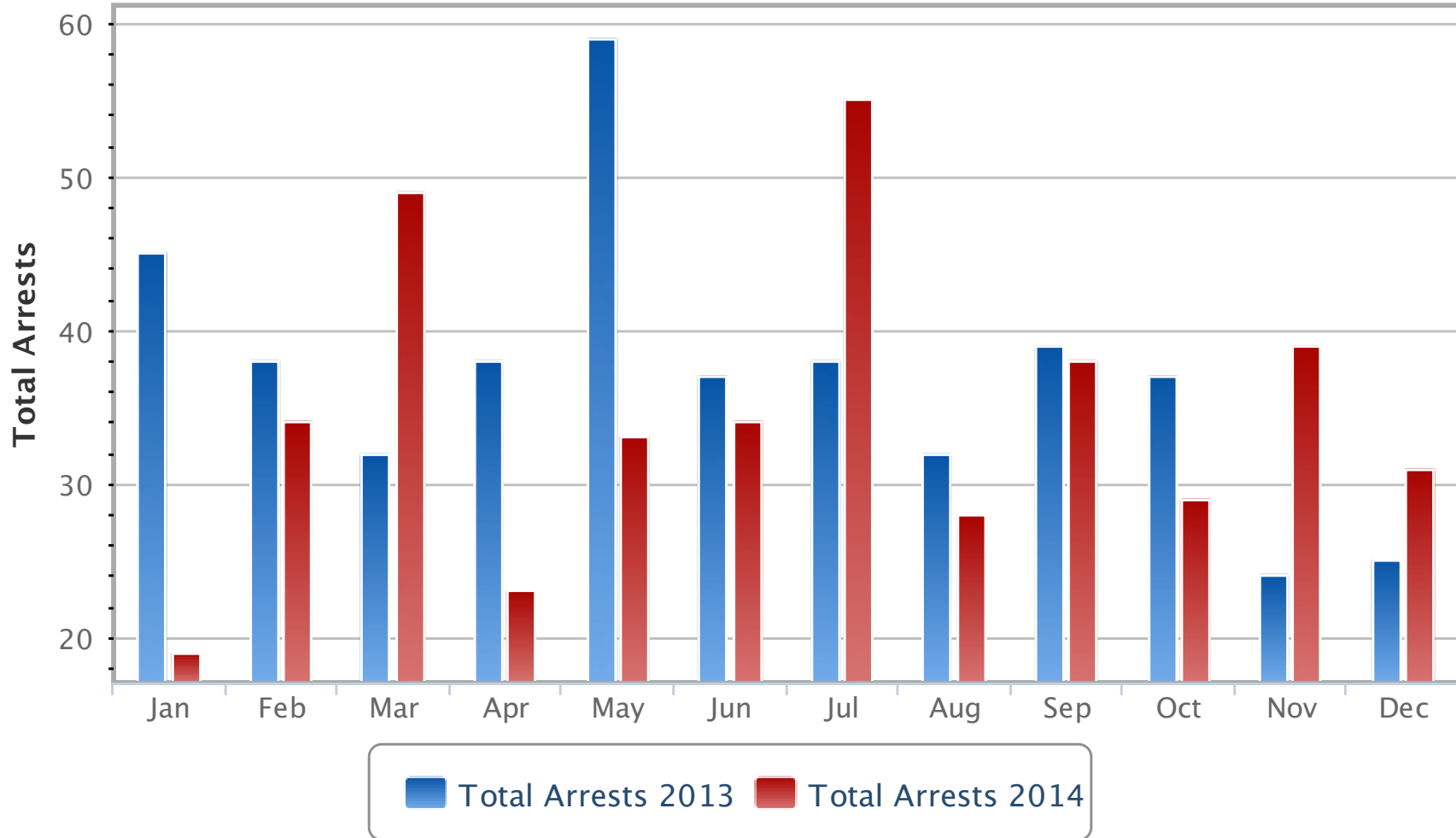
December 16<sup>th</sup>- SNB conducted a presentation for the Friends of the Davis International Center located at the Princeton University New Graduate College.

# Total Arrests 2014



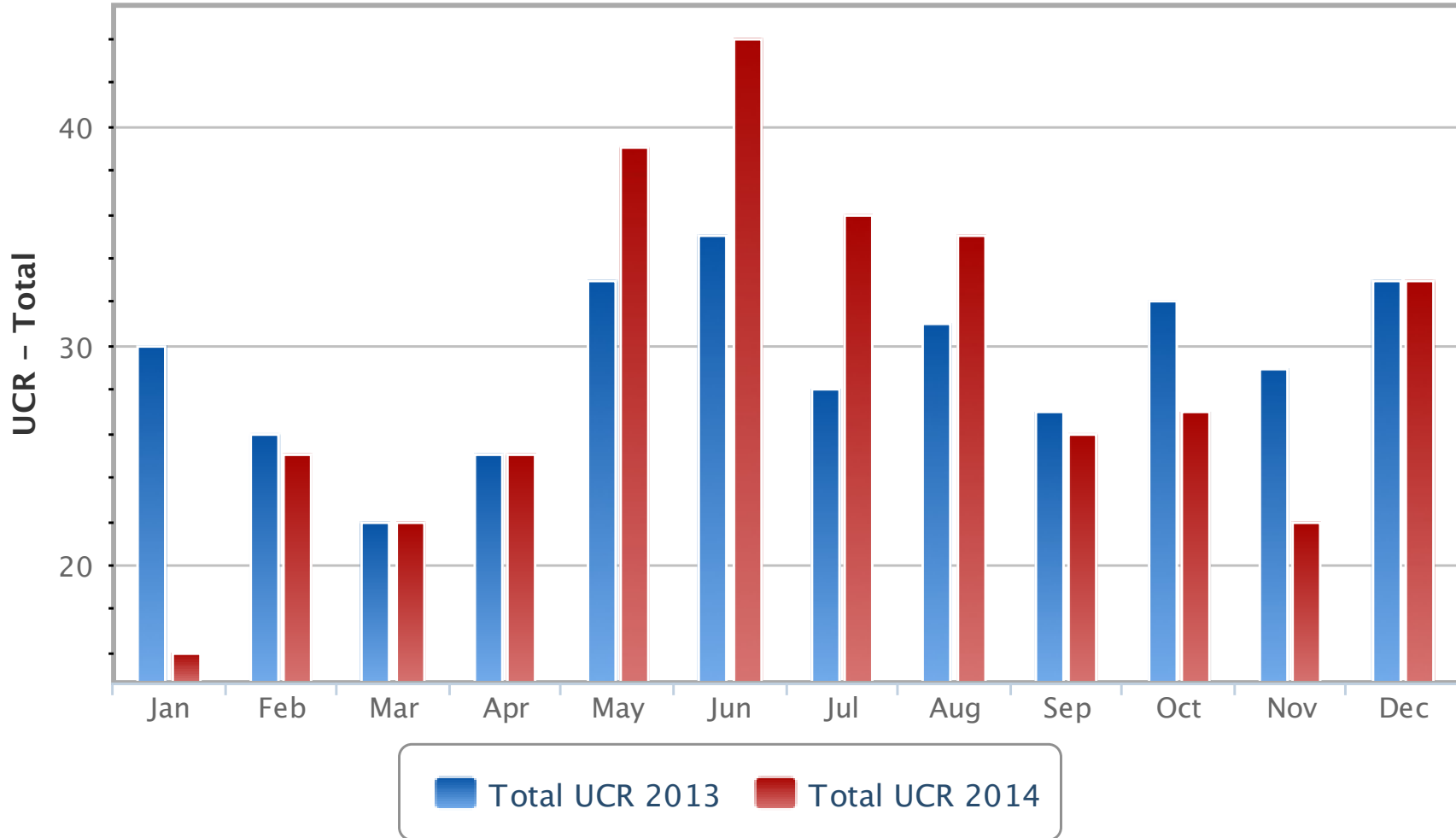

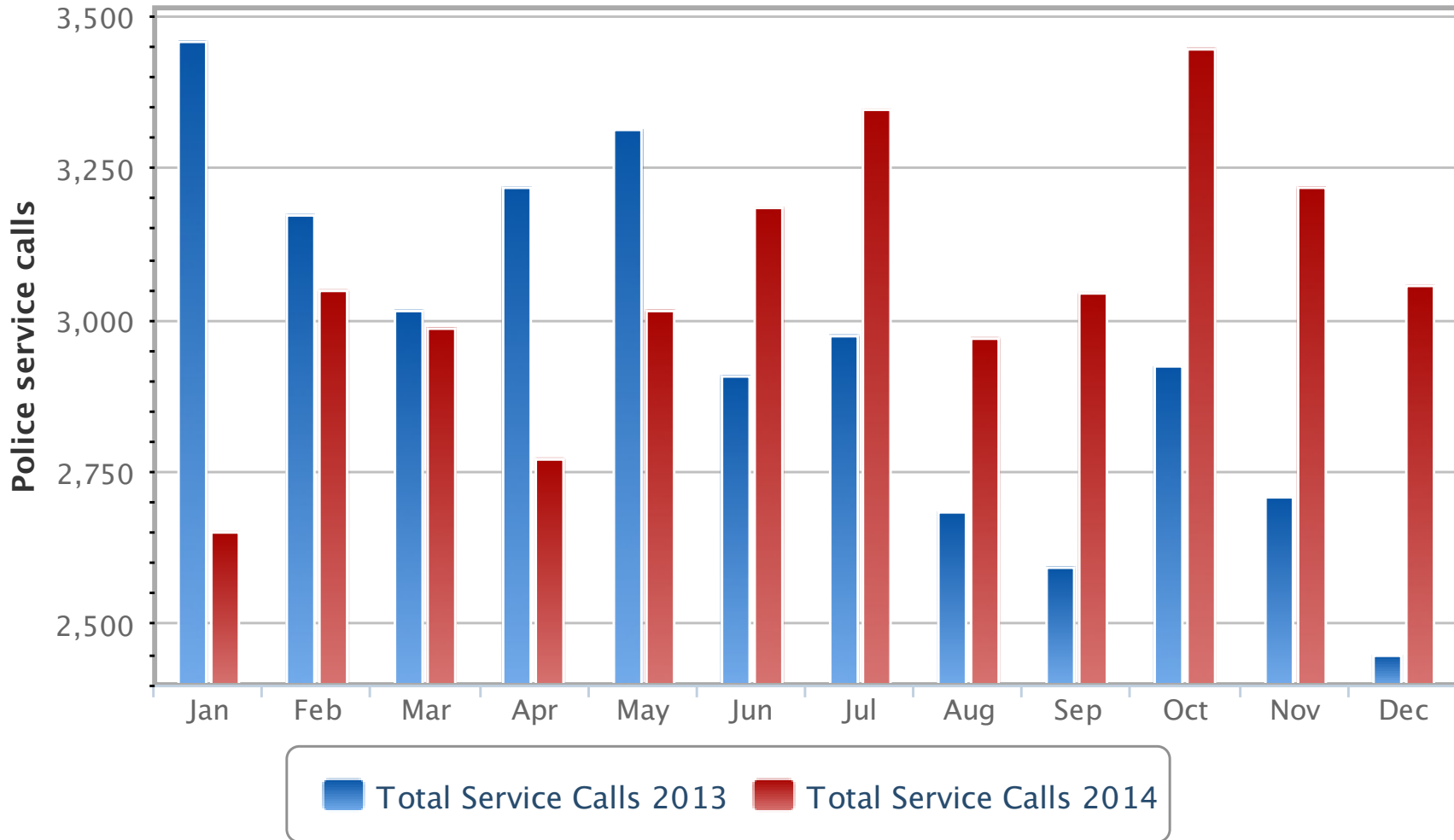

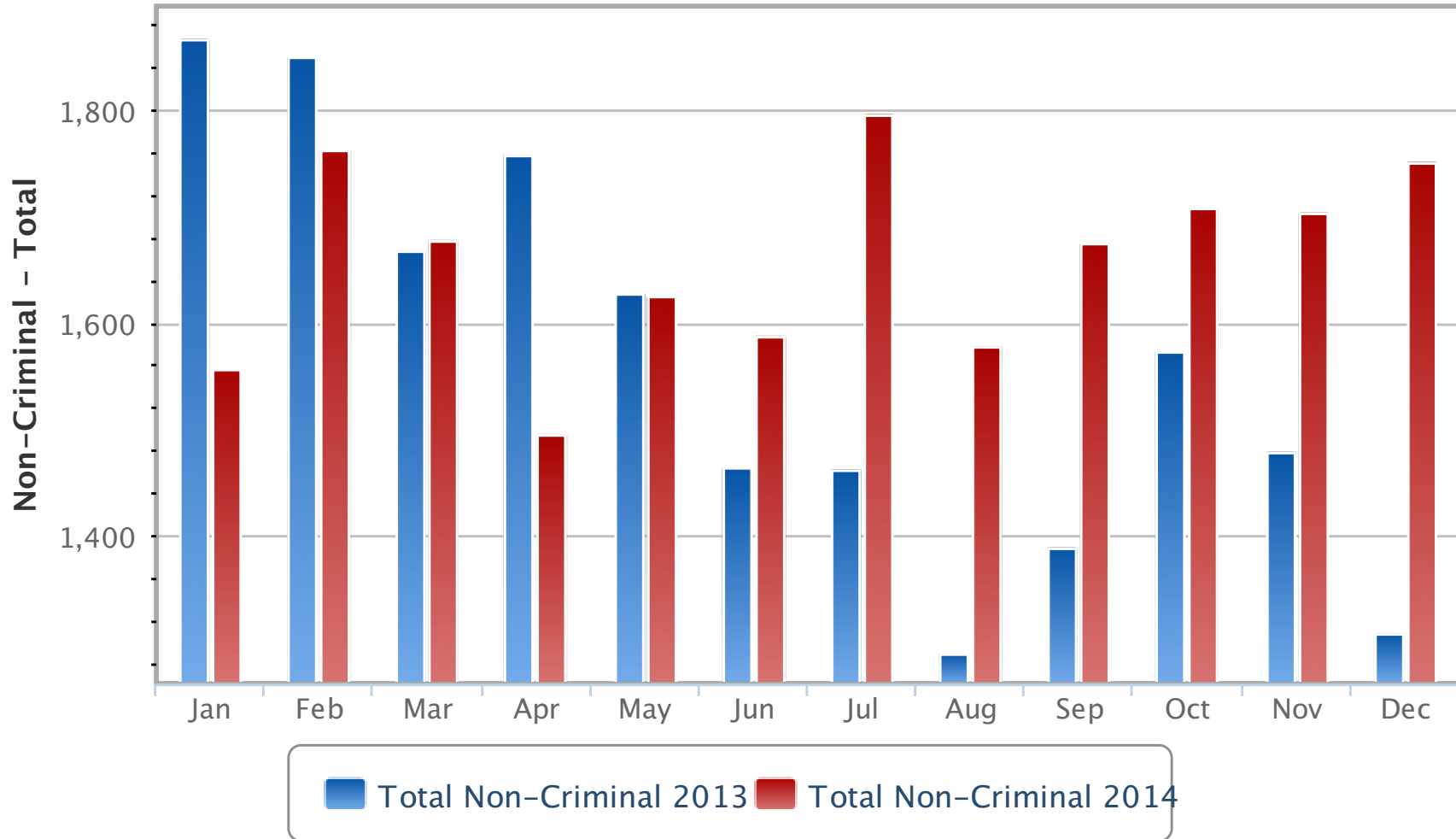

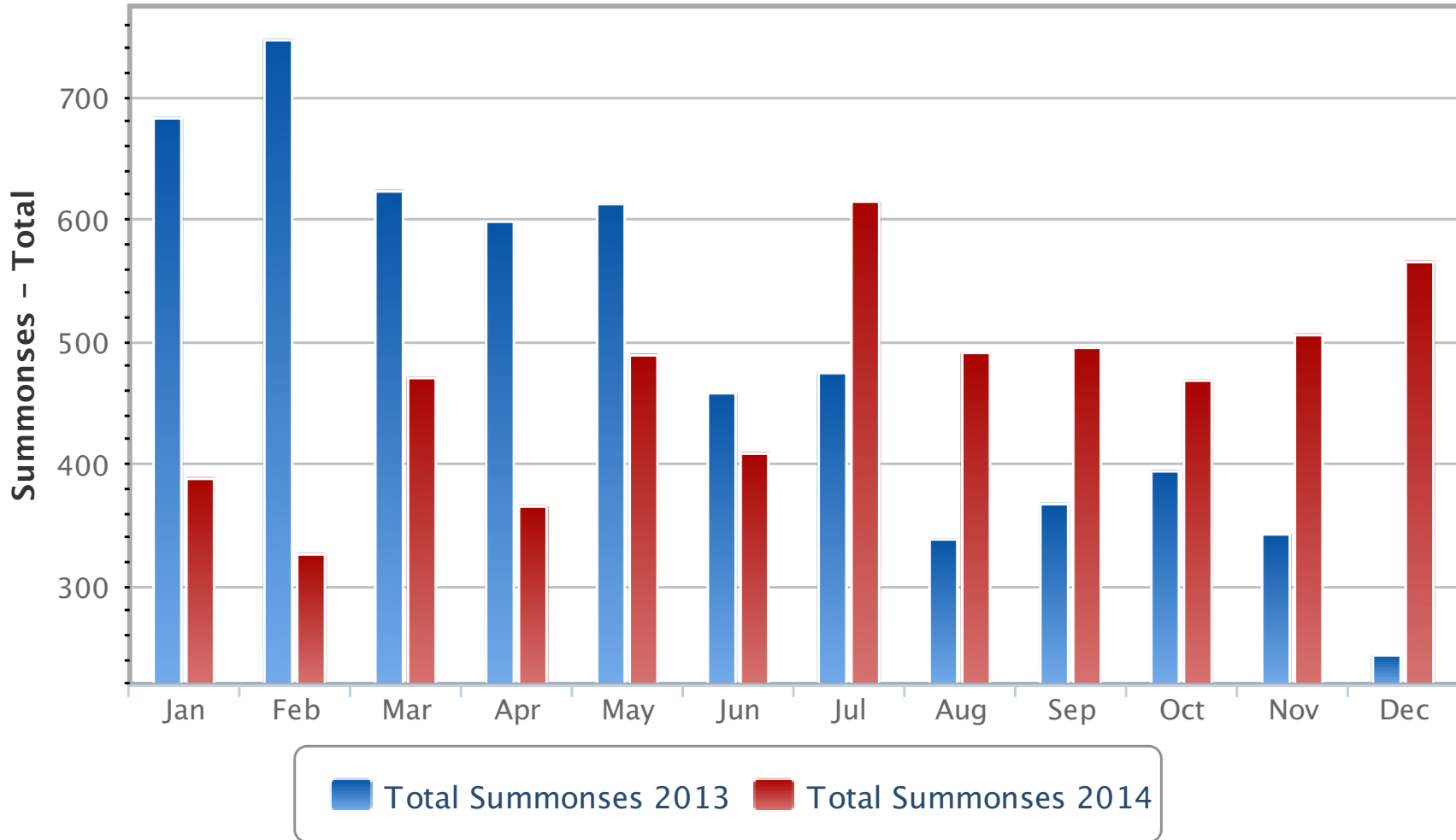

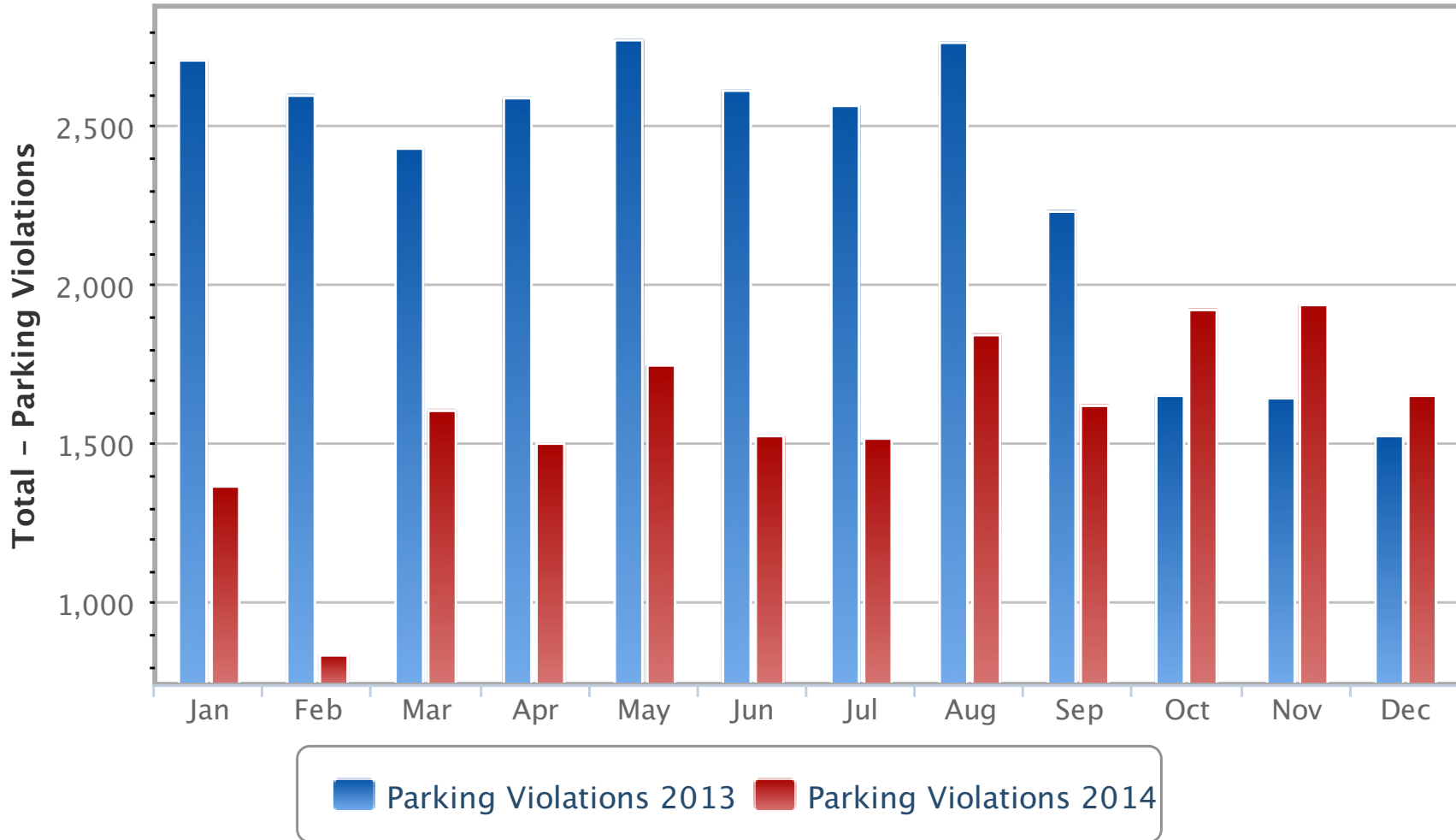

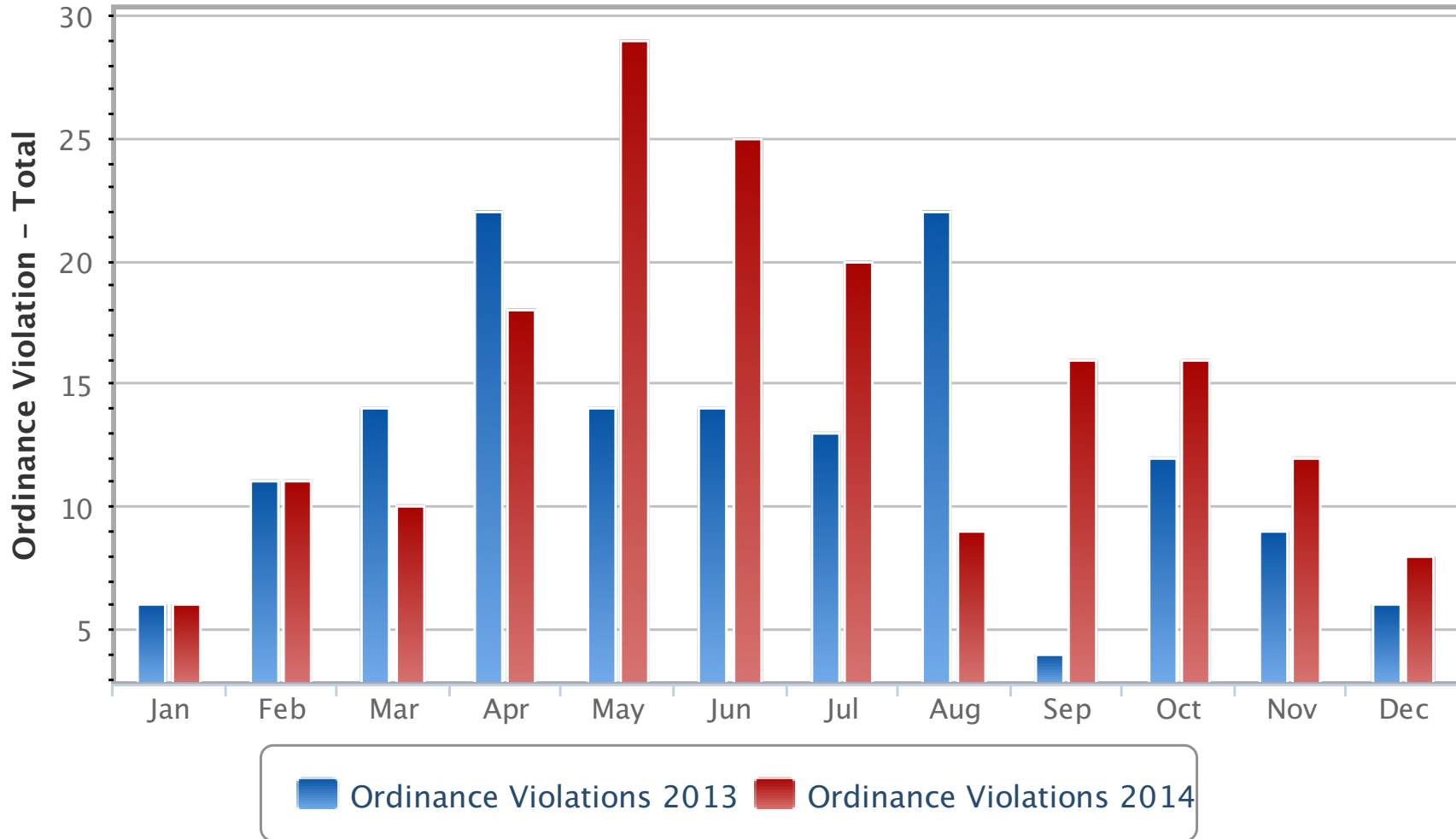

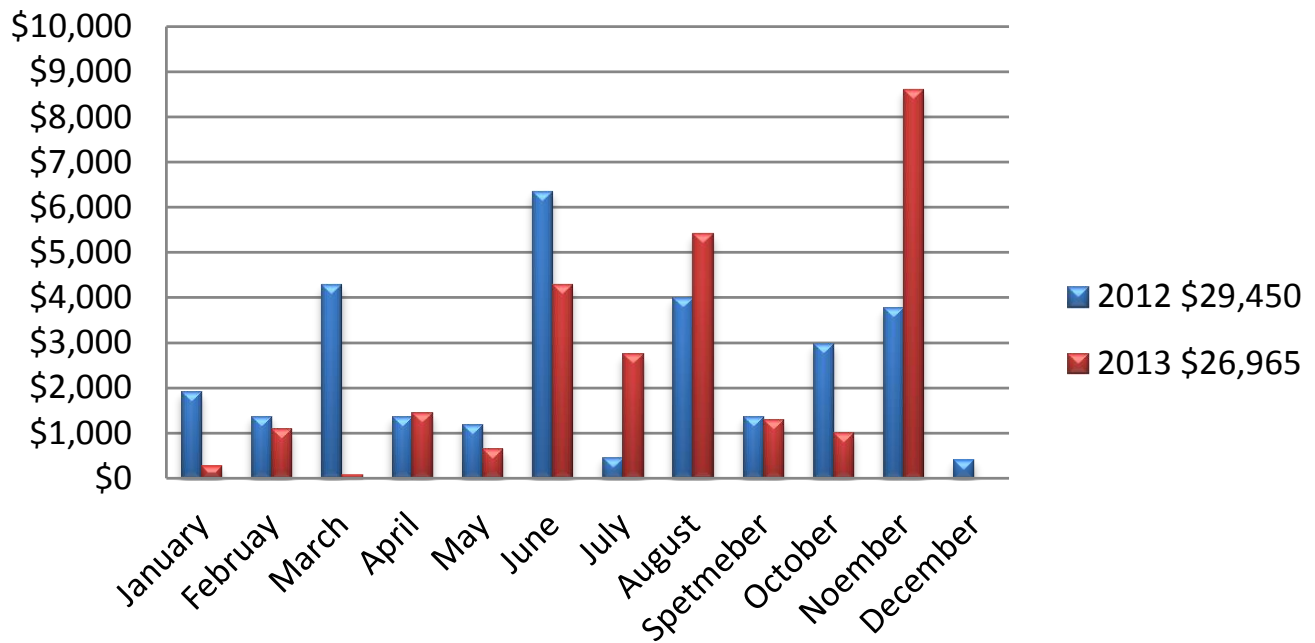
## Patrol Overtime



## Dispatch Overtime

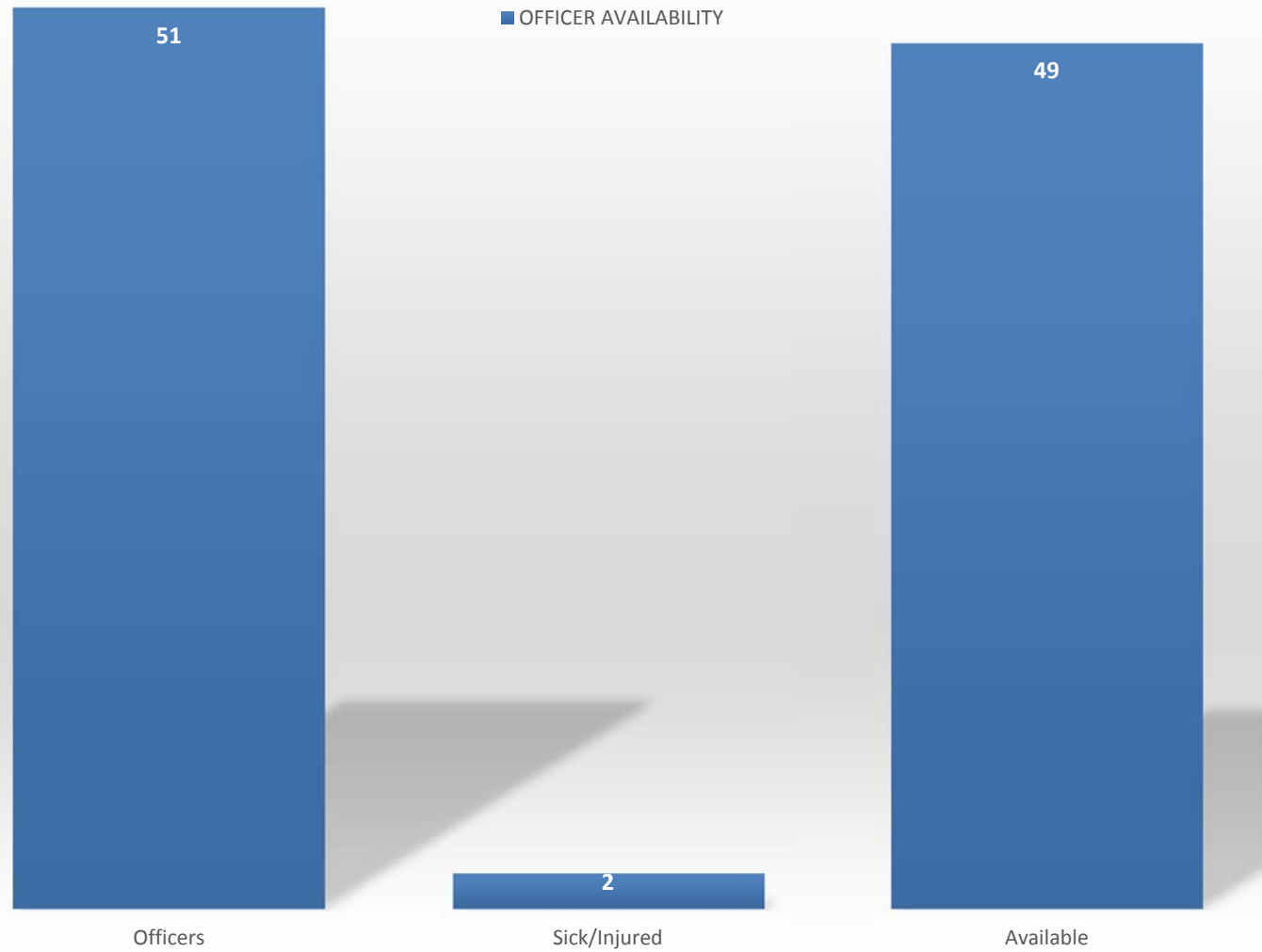


## Detective Overtime

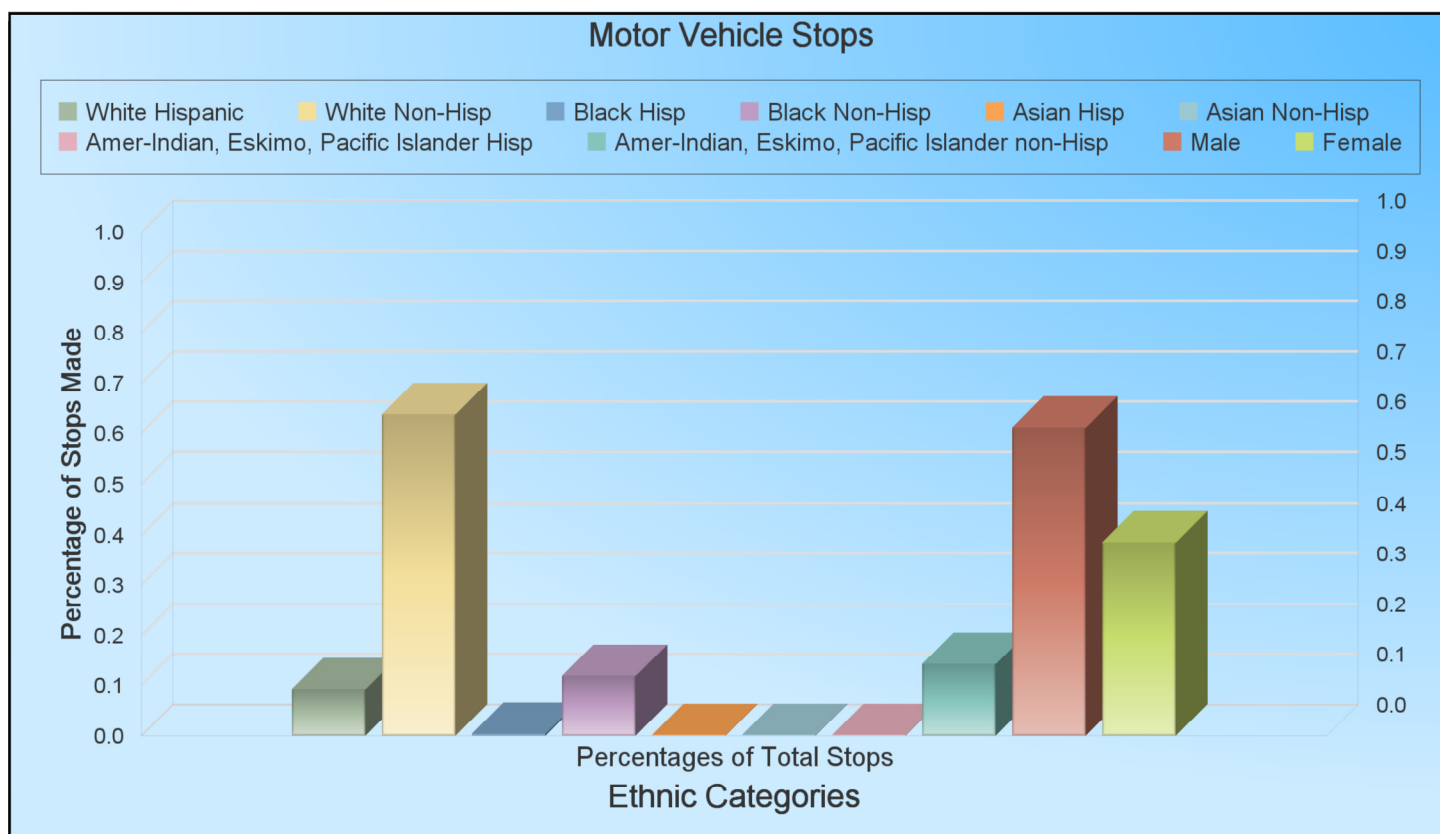

- ❖ Cpl. Solovay and K-9 Harris continue to attend the New Jersey State Police K-9 Training Academy, Patrol Class # 15, in order to be a certified Patrol K-9 Team. Training includes obedience, agility, evidence searching, tracking, building clearing, and criminal apprehension.
- ❖ On Wednesday, December 3, 2014, Cpl. Solovay and K9 Harris conducted an explosives sweep at the Princeton University Chapel at the request of Princeton University Department of Public Safety and the United States Secret Service in response to the visit of former United States President Jimmy Carter. The Mercer County Sheriff's Office K-9 Unit assisted with the sweep. K-9 Units remained onsite for the duration of the event at the request of the US Secret Service and conducted bag sniffs to ensure public safety.
- ❖ On Tuesday, December 16, 2014, Cpl. Solovay and K9 Harris were requested to respond to a bomb threat at South Plainfield High School. Unfortunately, due to K9 Harris suffering a minor injury to his leg, he was unable to respond to the request. K9 Harris has since recovered in full with no lingering issues.
