#### **Juvenile Report October 2015**

#### **Juveniles Afforded a Station House Adjustment**

A 16 year old boy brought an air soft gun and toy replica musket to school as part of his Halloween costume which was confiscated by school officials.

#### Family Crisis/Juvenile Mental Health Issues

A twelve year old boy was reported by the school that he had not been in attendance the previous two days and was seen hanging out at the Princeton Public Library instead. The boy was located and turned over to his mother. DCP&P continues to work with the family.

#### **Juvenile Incidents**

A 17 year old boy reported he was alarmed when an 18 year old classmate made comments related to a gun. The 18 year old maintained it was a careless comment meant to be a joke and recognized he should have used better judgment.

#### **Referrals to Division of Child Protection and Permanency**

A referral was made to DCP&P for a 15 year old boy who reported his father was verbally and sometimes physically abusive.

#### **Community Outreach**

Presented various community agency resources as part of the Hispanic Outreach Project at St. Paul's Church.

October 23- SNB conducted an anti-bullying presentation for the fifth grade students at the Johnson Park Elementary School.


October 26- SNB conducted a Halloween safety presentation for the Kindergarten students at Community Park Elementary School.

#### Princeton Police Department K-9 Unit Monthly Activity Report

- On Sunday, October 4, 2015, Cpl. Solovay and K-9 Harris conducted an explosive sweep in Princeton's Central Business District for the Hi-Tops Princeton Half Marathon.
- ❖ On Tuesday, October 13, 2015, Cpl. Solovay and K-9 Harris attended in-service training for the New Jersey Detect and Render Safe Task Force in Wall, NJ. The training was hosted by the Ocean County Sheriff's Department and operated by the New Jersey State Police K-9 Training Unit.
- ❖ On Tuesday, October 20, 2015, Cpl. Solovay and K-9 Harris responded to Johnson Park Elementary School after a threat to the school was received by school administrators. Cpl. Solovay and K-9 Harris conducted an exterior perimeter check of the school while police officers conducted a walk-through of the interior of the school. Nothing threatening or suspicious was located. The incident is believed to be another case of "swatting," and is being investigated by the Princeton Police Department Detective Bureau.
- ❖ On Friday, October 30, 2015, Cpl. Solovay and K-9 Harris responded to Rider University at the request of the Lawrence Police Department and Rider University Public Safety on a report of a suspicious individual who was peering into windows around the dormitories. Cpl. Solovay and K-9 Harris entered the densely wooded area located behind the buildings in an attempt to conduct a track of the suspect, however no suspect was located. The incident remains under investigation by the Lawrence Police Department.
